

## CROOKSTON MUSIC TRIP ELIGIBILITY POLICY

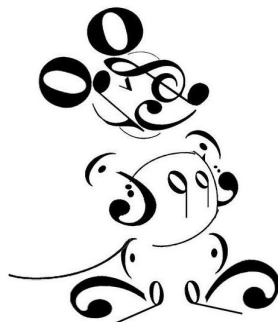
The student intending to participate in the Crookston Music Trip Parent Organization (CMTPO) music trip must be a fulltime student in at least one (1) of the three (3) music ensembles offered by Crookston High School throughout the entire academic year of the music trip (2020-2021) **AND** must have been a fulltime student in at least one (1) of the three (3) music ensembles during the academic years 2018-2019, 2019-2020, and 2020-2021. If a student transfers into ISD#593 from another school district, the student shall be subject to similar eligibility requirements as an ISD#593 student as applied and interpreted by the Crookston High School Principal and CMTPO committee. In the case of a “home-schooled” student, the Crookston High School Principal and CMTPO committee shall require written **and** oral information in deciding whether the home-schooled student has sufficient music education to meet the eligibility qualification requirements.

Each participant in the 2020-2021 CMTPO music trip is held to a high standard of conduct and achievement. As a result, the following eligibility requirements must be met in order to participate in the 2020-2021 music trip:

- No student participant shall travel independently or make independent travel arrangements unless such arrangements are necessary to facilitate the student’s participation in a school sanctioned activity. A student’s independent travel arrangements must be approved in advanced by the Crookston High School Principal and CMTPO committee.
- On or before February 1, 2020, the sum of at least \$1,500.00 must be deposited to the student participant’s account.
- The student participant **shall not** have a grade of “F” or designation of incomplete as of March 31, 2021.
- The student participant **shall not** during the time period April 1, 2020 through April 1, 2021 have a violation of any provision of the Minnesota High School League Policies or the CHS Student Handbook Policies, or the Music Trip Code of Conduct.
- The student participant **shall not** have two (2) or more violations of any of the provisions of the Minnesota State High School League Policies or the CHS Student Handbook Policies, or the Music Trip Code of Conduct either individually or in combination in the academic years, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2019-2020, or 2020-2021.
- During the academic year 2020-2021, the student participant **shall not** have a violation of any specific requirements of any music organization in which the student participant is enrolled or in which the student participates.
- The student shall comply with each requirement of the music organization(s) in which the student participant is enrolled or participates.

### REFUND POLICY

A student who no longer desires to participate in the CMTPO music trip of 2020-2021 will be refunded only the cash donations contributed to his/her account. The student **WILL NOT** be refunded any funds which have been raised through the “music bucks” or “frozen foods”, or any other fundraisers approved by the School Board. Absolutely no refund will be made to any student after the first deposit has been made by CMTPO to the travel agent.
